\*In 1969 and prior years, a "Pass-Fail" system was in effect rather than a "Credit-No Credit" system. Under Pass-Fail, a failing grade was included in the student's GPA. Failing grades earned under the Pass-Fail system are included in the "E" totals. The "Pass" grades are counted as "Credit" grades. From 1972-73 until 1974-75, the students could declare the CR-NC option up to the eighth week of the quarter. Beginning 1975-76, the CR-NC option could only be declared during the first two weeks of the quarter.

\*\*\*GPA's are interpreted A = 4.0; A- = 3.6; B+ = 3.4; B = 3.0; etc.; X = Condition; I = Incomplete;  
V = Visitor; W = Withdrawal; CR = Credit; NC = No Credit.

†In 1965-66, no withdrawals were permitted after the second week. From 1966-67 to 1971-72, a "W" withdrawal was permitted up to the sixth week; and thereafter, a "WP" (Withdraw Passing) or "WF" (Withdraw Failing) was recorded. WP's and WF's are included in "W" totals. From 1972-73 onward, a straight W grade was given up to the eighth week, and no withdrawal was permitted thereafter. Beginning 1975-76, students could not withdraw after the second week without the instructor's permission.
